As we begin our last few weeks of school for 2023 it's a great time to celebrate our learning success at St Bernadettes. The staff have been looking at some of the results achieved in NAPLAN, Pat Reading (Pat-R) and Pat Maths (Pat-M) standardised tests. In Year 3 and Year 5 our students are achieving results that are well above the state results in both Literacy and Numeracy. This is a huge achievement as it means that our students were able to make growth even with Covid interruptions.

Both the Pat-R and Pat-M tests are conducted in Term 4 each year from Year 2 - 6. Once again our students have demonstrated growth and when compared to the norm, our results are strong. These results are to be celebrated as it means that our teachers have prepared lesson sequences that not only support growth but are engaging for students.

Our staff over the coming weeks will be diving into our data further and will be involved in handing over all of their student data to the teacher who will be teaching these children in 2024. This is a practice we undergo each year so that when planning for 2024 the teachers have a clear plan of where to begin.

Last night myself and a number of staff members had the privilege of attending First Reconciliation. It was a lovely celebration of this special Sacrament. Congratulations to these Year 2 students.

First Sunday of Advent Year B

Gospel

Mark 13:33-37

Jesus said to his disciples: 'Be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come. It is like a man travelling abroad: he has gone from home, and left his servants in charge, each with his own task; and he has told the doorkeeper to stay awake. So stay awake, because you do not know when the master of the house is coming, evening, midnight, cockcrow, dawn; if he comes unexpectedly, he must not find you asleep. And what I say to you I say to all: Stay awake!'



REFLECTION by Fr Michael Tate

Timely Living and the End of History

Our Lord portrays himself as the Master who goes away on a journey. It is certain that he will return, even if no-one in his household knows exactly when. That is *our* situation. What do we do in anticipation?

Our Lord, the Master, indicates we have a choice. We can close our eyes and enter into the world of dreams where we create our own fantasy futures, or we can stay awake and alert to do what Our Lord wants us to do: 'He left his *servants* in charge, giving to each his work.'

You and me – his servants – have a particular role or work in and for this phase of human history. A deep down intuition, prompted by the Holy Spirit, indicates what this is. We must be true to this assignment.

We could take a moment to pray that, when the Lord returns, we may hear: 'Come, good and *faithful* servant, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you since the foundation of the world.'
